I am writing to inform you of an upcoming engagement opportunity in Lindsey Park community. This is our second round of engagement, and our project team is studying the barriers and opportunities to make it easier for Calgarians to travel to the MNP Community & Sport Centre (formally known as the Repsol Sport Centre).
